Whatever Happened to the Senior Pictures????

Most of us in the classes prior to the 1990s remember the large framed pictures of the graduating classes that donned the halls of the old high school. Where are they now?

They were all hanging at the old school when the Spring Break Quake occurred in 1993. Since the temblor left the building unusable, portable classrooms were leased at the High School building on Cole Street, and the students all moved to the north campus. The old building was dangerous to enter so access was limited to removing students' belongings and other essential property. The rest, including the old pictures, was left for another time.

A year or so later, the senior pictures were removed to be taken to be stored. The building had been unheated, and there was damage. Some of the frames and some of the glass was broken. Roger Engle '62 took charge of moving the pictures to the Mulino Grange hall where they were stored. The class pictures were composed from individual seniors' pictures, and ecause of the dampness, some of them had dropped to the

To the rescue came Bill Barth '60, a professional photographer, who volunteered to take the pictures to his home and begin restoration. He wisely decided that it was best to remove the individual photos, identify the people and archive them by class. He has done that. His plan is to scan, name and touch up (as needed) each of the photos and store them digitally so that they might be used in any number of ways. Ideas include arranging them by class and making posters, make power point

presentations, and reframing and displaying them at the new high school.

To this end, an archival quality scanner has been purchased by Sheryl Erickson '63 for Bill's use to do the scanning. Sheryl is actively seeking student interns, who can help with this process. At the conclusion of this project, the scanner will go to the Molalla Area Historical Society for their use in archiving materials. It would also be available for any other Alumni projects.

Bill has been fighting cancer for a while now, and recently received a bone marrow transplant. He is looking forward to resuming this project as his health improves, and we wish him the best as he continues his journey.
