

## 2010 Molalla Alumni Scholarship

The Alumni Association of Molalla High School is proud to be able to offer these scholarships to any graduating MRSD senior who wishes to further his or her education at any accredited post high school institution. This scholarship is funded from the donations of Alumni of MHS and individuals in the Molalla community.

**Award:** Multiple awards given—minimum of \$1,500.00 each—including four named scholarships: The Damm-Waiste, The Marquardt, The Trullinger/Sanden, and The Rebekah Lodge. Additional scholarships may be given at the discretion of the Scholarship Committee.

**Eligibility:** A current senior attending Molalla High School who has maintained at least a 3.0 accumulated GPA.

**Where:** Any accredited institution of higher learning, community college, 4-year college, university or trade school.

**Selection Based On:**

1. Scholastic record
2. Community and school involvement
3. Personal character
4. Ability to organize application and follow directions
5. Ability to communicate clearly and succinctly

**Deadline:** Application may be mailed (MASF P.O. Box 1050) but must arrive on or before April 14, 2010. You may also hand deliver them to Joan Deardorff at Doubletree's office in the Mainstreet Showhouse, 115 E. Main Street, Suite #9 Molalla. **Procedure:**

1. Complete **all** the information required on the application.
2. Staple application pages together in this order (please, **no folders**)
  - Cover page
  - Essays
  - Activities
  - Letters of recommendation
  - Certified high school transcript through second trimester
  - College transcript, if applicable
3. The scholarship winners will be selected by the Scholarship Committee and will be notified at the date of your Senior Awards.

**Awarding Scholarship:**

1. **Recipient** must verify high school graduation by the enrollment in a post high school educational institution. This verification must include the institution, college or university registrar's copy of their enrolled classes along with your student ID number. The award will be drafted in the form of a check made out to your account at the institution, college or university at which you are enrolled.
2. Termination of the students' school program will result in the cancellation of the award.

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## **Additional requirements:**

1. Attach to your application, one letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, counselor, or administrator from your school. They must identify themselves, their position at school, and how they know you.
2. Also attach to your application, one letter of recommendation from an adult who is **not related** and is **outside** of the school setting. This person must also identify himself or herself and how he/she knows you and the circumstances for your relationship with this person. (ex. Church youth pastor, Camp Fire advisor, Boy Scout advisor, doctor, family friend, etc.)  
**NOTE:** Your personal friend, though an adult, **may not** write this letter.
