

2010 Molalla Alumni Vocational Scholarship

The Alumni Association of Molalla High School is proud to be able to offer this scholarship to any graduating MRSD senior who wishes to further his or her education at any accredited post high school institution. This scholarship is funded from the donations of Alumni of MHS and individuals.

Award: Minimum of \$1,500.00

Eligibility: A current senior attending Molalla High School who has maintained at least a 2.0 accumulated GPA, and plans to attend an accredited institution or trade school leading to a certificate of completion.

Where: Any accredited institution of higher learning, community college, 4-year college, university or trade school.

Selection Based On:

1. Attendance record
2. Community and school involvement
3. Personal character
4. Ability to follow directions

Deadline: Application may be mailed to MASF, P.O. Box 1050. Mail early enough to be received on or before **April 14, 2010**. You may also hand deliver them to Joan Deardorff at Doubletree's office in the Mainstreet Showhouse, 115 E. Main Street, Suite #9 Molalla.

Procedure:

1. Complete **all** the information required on the application
2. Staple application pages together in this order (please, **no folders**)
 - Cover page
 - Activities, awards, and commendations list
 - Letters of recommendation from high school staff and community members
 - Certified high school transcript through second trimester
 - Work Study program information, if available
3. Winner (s) will be notified at the date of your Senior Awards

Additional requirements:

1. Attach to your application, one letter of recommendation from a teacher, coach, counselor, or administrator from your school. They must identify themselves, their position at school, and how they know you.
2. Also attach to your application, one letter of recommendation from an adult who is **not related** and is **outside** of the school setting. This person must also identify himself or herself and how he/she knows you and the circumstances for your relationship with this person. (ex. Church youth pastor, Camp Fire advisor, Boy Scout advisor, doctor, family friend, etc.)
NOTE: Your personal friend, though an adult, **may not** write this letter.
