

## Molalla Alumni Career/Technical Scholarship Scholarship Agreement

AMOUNT:	Two (2) at \$2,000 each.
PURPOSE:	To provide financial assistance to students interested in pursuing additional training in any technical, vocational, or career field; not requiring a four year degree. The following list contains examples of fields of study that qualify for this scholarship, <u>but are not necessarily limited to this list</u> : plumbing, electrical, computer science, art, beauty, business, agriculture, forestry welding, mechanical welding, and firefighting, allied health, criminal justice, mechanical, water/environmental.
	This scholarship is intended for someone pursuing a 1 year certificate or 2 year CTE degree and heading straight into the workforce.
<b>REQUIREMENTS:</b>	Applicants must:
	<ul> <li>Be a current senior attending Molalla High School.</li> <li>Enroll full-time at CCC (minimum 12 hours) in a Career/Technical program pursuing a one or two-year certificate.</li> <li>Have and maintain a cumulative GPA of 2.0 or better.</li> <li>Have the potential to complete the program.</li> </ul>
APPLICATION PROCEDURE:	<ul> <li>Complete the on-line CCC Scholarship Application form. (clackamas.edu/scholarships)</li> <li>Include two current letters of recommendation.</li> <li>Include an unofficial transcript.</li> </ul>
